The institutions established by Kinsey and his collaborators


How did Kinsey go main-stream in conservative America?

Dr. Kinsey and his collaborators knew that conservative Americans would not buy the premise that any form of sexual expression should be allowed, even applauded. He understood that he must permeate all professional disciplines to spread his theories. Professionals rely on accrediting institutions to certify its "experts" in particular fields of medicine, social work, religion, education, and the military, etc... Dr. Kinsey and his associates set out immediately to establish these accrediting institutions in order to legitimize his "science." By the way, his "science" on childhood sexuality involved sexual abuse of children. The first of these institutions was the Institute for the Advanced Study of Human Sexuality (**IASHS**) which was formed in 1968 at the University of San Francisco California by Kinsey, Wardell Pomeroy, a board member of the Penthouse Forum Board and Ted McIlvenna. In 1964 the first "sexology" degrees were given by NYU. Examples of course work at various institutions that confer these degrees are: Erotic Massage; Self-Massage; Sex Surrogate Therapy and Forensic Sexology. Derek Calderwood the first director of the NYU program was a leading homosexual advocate who later died of AIDS.

In 1957 the Society for the Scientific Study of Sex (**SSSS**) was formed by Wardell Pomeroy, Gebhard, George, Calderwood and Vern Bullough several of whom still work at the **Kinsey Institute**. Albert Ellis, a Penthouse Forum Board member, was one of the founders of American Association of Sex Educators, Counselors & Therapists (**AASECT**) who sponsored the "World Pornography Conference" at California State University in Northridge which was dubbed as a "porn trade show" by the California Legislature (Democratic majority).

The Sex Information & Education Council of the United States (**SIECUS**) is another offshoot of the Kinsey agenda to take care of educating our children about sex. **SIECUS** was founded by the **Kinsey Institute** and one of its first leaders was Dr. Mary Calderone of **Planned Parenthood**.
