CWA's Statement of Faith:

- We believe marriage is between one man and one woman, that sexual activity outside of that marriage is sin, and that God created the human race male and female.

- **Religious Liberty:** CWA supports the God-given rights of individuals in the United States and other nations to pray, worship, and express their beliefs without fear of discrimination or persecution.
- **Family:** CWA believes that marriage consists of one man and one woman. We seek to protect and support the Biblical design of marriage and the gift of children.
- **Sexual Exploitation:** CWA endeavors to fight all pornography, obscenity, prostitution, and sex slavery.
- **Education:** CWA supports reform of public education by returning authority to parents and also accessibility to alternatives forms of education.
- **National Sovereignty:** CWA believes that neither the United Nations nor any other international organization should have authority over the United States in any area. We also

believe the United States has the right and duty to protect and secure our national borders. We believe in budget restraint which embodies responsible spending, small government and a budget in which the U.S. government spends within its means and ceases to steal from future generations.

- **Support for Israel:** CWA believes that the people and nations who stand with Israel and the Jewish people will be blessed by God. We believe that any foreign policy effort to withdraw U.S. support for Israel is in direct contradiction to America's national interests.
