WHAT IS YWA?

YWA brings active groups of like-minded women together to promote conservative values in their community, on their high school/college campuses, and in their nation.



THE MISSION

The mission of YWA is to train and empower the next generation of young women leaders to protect and promote Biblical values on their campuses and in society, thereby reversing the moral decline in our nation.

YWA CHAPTERS

YWA Chapters are groups of women (and like-minded men) who meet regularly to learn about public policy issues, pray, and act. Your group can meet monthly, semi-monthly, or even weekly. Each meeting consists of a short devotional, discussion of a current policy topic, an action item, and time spent in prayer.

CWA publishes a monthly lesson plan you can use for your meetings; CWA also provides a monthly newsletter, policy papers, brochures, and other resources to help you educate your campus about conservative values.

CWA will also send you action alerts to let you know when and how you can make your voice heard.

We'll even help you host special events on your campus — from forums and seminars to charity fundraisers and military appreciation banquets. CWA provides you with all of the information you'll need for your Chapter meetings and events.

Our country needs young women like you to be a voice for Christian values on your campus!

THE PURPOSE of a YWA Chapter is to **educate, pray, and act.**

Here are just a few examples of what your Chapter can do:

Educate

- Hold meetings to keep members informed on public policy issues.
- Host forums and speaker events that will educate your campus on conservative issues.

Pray

- Hold prayer meetings to pray for your elected officials and our nation
- Organize prayer vigils outside abortion clinics/government buildings

Act

- Lobby on Capitol Hill
- Raise awareness/funds by holding themed events or galas
- Volunteer for worthy causes like pregnancy care centers
- Attend conferences and rallies
- Hold voter registration drives
- Write op-eds for your campus or local newspapers
