

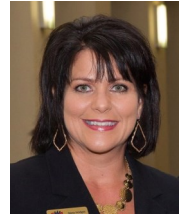

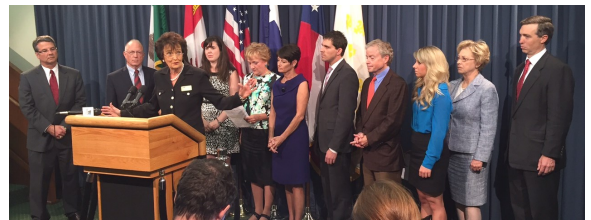
Dear Faithful Friends,


