CWA Leadership Opportunities

Today more than any other time in American history, women are seeking to influence public policy decisions. CWA of Georgia has many volunteer leadership opportunities that enable citizens to turn **concern** into **action**.

Below is a list of volunteer position descriptions that are currently vacant within CWA of Georgia. Prayerfully consider applying* for one that best suits your interests and abilities.

Prayer/Action Chapter Leaders

Do you desire to see our country radically affected through the energized efforts of prayer warriors? Consider starting a Prayer/Action Chapter in your community.

This position involves leading a Prayer/Action Chapter that normally meets once per month. The strength of CWA lies in the power of collective prayer and action at the grassroots across the nation. Prayer/Action Chapters connect Christians who are concerned about America in a united prayer and action network. Through our chapters, we keep **informed** about current issues, **expose** those forces weakening the family, and **educate** others and ourselves in the government process. Then, armed with this information, we pray diligently for our nation and its leaders.

Home Team Captains

This position is similar to the Prayer/Action Chapter Leader position, except you do not meet monthly. The Home Team Captain (HTC) communicates with her team via phone, e-mail and other digital formats about current prayer and action items.

CWA Legislative Liaison

Do you enjoy the legislative process and have a desire to work on family-related and pro-life issues here in Georgia? Consider becoming a Legislative Liaison.

This position involves working with legislation that comes before the state legislature via lobbying, networking, giving testimony and educating constituents. An understanding of the legislative process and an ability to deal gracefully with opposing positions to influence public policy are crucial to the position. Equally, it is important to have an understanding of the state legislative body, the basic legislative process, the purpose and goals of CWA, the positions CWA has taken on issues, and CWA's standard of professionalism in speech and manner. The Legislative Liaison is in a key position as the main source of legislative information to CWA of Georgia. CWA will equip you to monitor state legislation and lobby our state legislature.

CWA Communications Coordinator

Do you enjoy writing and speaking? Perhaps the Communications Coordinator role is a perfect fit for your gifts in communication.

This position involves working with a variety of media at the state and local levels. The Coordinator needs strong writing, speaking and communication abilities to influence public policy and create a positive public image of CWA in our state. Some understanding of the nature of media (the good and the bad), the basic legislative process, CWA's positions on the issues, and CWA's standard of professionalism in speech and manner is important for this position. CWA would equip you to work with the print, radio and TV media.
