Conservative Women Endorse Tom Graves Over Ex Rep. Bob Barr

“No way Georgia voters will want Barr back after marriage betrayal”

Washington, D.C. – Concerned Women Political Action Committee (CWPAC) has announced its endorsement of Congressman Tom Graves in Georgia’s 14 District.

Concerned Women PAC, established in 2002 by Founder and Chairman Beverly LaHaye, is affiliated with Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee, **the nation’s largest public policy women’s organization with more than 500,000 grassroots members nationwide.**

Congressman Graves has already racked up a 100 percent record with Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee’s scorecard and has garnered similar ratings from both fiscal and social conservative organizations.

Bob Barr Snapshot

- **After authoring the 1996 Defense of Marriage Act, Bob Barr came out against DOMA during his failed bid for president on the Libertarian ticket.**
- **Congressman Bob Barr authored a successful amendment blocking a Washington, D.C., marijuana initiative. But then after leaving Congress, he went to work as a lobbyist for the Marijuana Policy Project.**
- **Bob Barr voted for No Child Left Behind, which massively expanded the role of the federal government in education.**
