

When Will Your Pastor's Sermon Be a "Hate Crime" ?

In Sweden:

- A pastor was charged with "hate speech" for a sermon about homosexuality.

In Canada:

- It is illegal to criticize homosexuality over the airwaves.
- A publisher and advertiser have been fined for printing Bible verses about homosexuality.

In the United States:

- "Hate Crimes" legislation was passed by the Senate on June 13, 2004 as an amendment to a Defense Authorization Bill.

In California:

- Pending "hate crimes" legislation continues to threaten freedom of speech and freedom of religion. If this legislation becomes law, thoughts, rather than actions, will be criminalized. Gov. Schwarzenegger needs to hear from all Californians, asking him to **veto SB 1234**.
