"On April 26, 2006, CWA of Illinois' Action Director, Karen Hayes, and state lobbyist, Fran Eaton, joined scores of women at our nation's capitol in Washington D.C. to lobby as a coalition, "Real Women's Voices."

Visiting staff at both Sen. Obama and Sen. Durbin's offices, Karen and Fran provided them with information on three bills and asked for their assistance. Dr. Alveda King, niece of the late Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., accompanied them to Sen. Obama's office, and two representatives of Democrats for Life also joined in. The legislation included efforts to ban human cloning, to inform moms about their unborn children's pain and options prior to abortion, and to stop adults from taking minors across state lines to evade state parental involvement statutes."
