## “TRAFFICKING LOVE”

### *Dialogue Questions*

#### **1. Supply and Demand** *(Choose one of the following to discuss at your table and then discuss others as time allows.)*

- Were you aware of this reality? How long have you been aware? How did you acquire your awareness? Why do you think so many are unaware?
- How does our culture fuel the demand?
- Discuss the modern day phenomenon of pimping. (the term has come to mean “to improve upon”) Have we moved beyond tolerance to glamorization? Contrast the image of the pimp, john or gentleman’s club in our culture with the image of prostitutes, whores, ho’s, sluts, tramps, lot lizards, and now even “disposable humans.” How have these terms conditioned our thinking and our actions?

#### **2. God’s Word – God’s economy of Supply and Demand**

- Discuss the seeming contradiction between the abundance of God’s love, grace, mercy, compassion, and justice and lack of it in human trafficking. - Where is God’s love in the midst of pain and suffering?

#### **3. God’s Word – “Pure Religion”, “True Love”, and “Living Faith”**

- Discuss the idea of “Pure Religion” in a “religious culture”
- Discuss “True Love” in a culture flooded with “love” ideas
- Discuss “Living Faith” in a culture consumed with “Faith Debates” and Theological arguments

#### **4. Roundtable Prayer time** *(Encourage prayer for)*

- The victims
- The counselors & non governmental agencies
- Activists (who often burn out in underfunded/overworked service)
- Law enforcement
- The church & your personal response
- Federal, state and local lawmakers?
