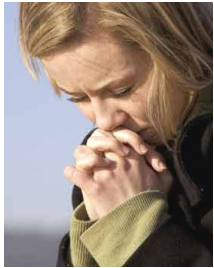

The purpose of the EAL program is to encourage each member of the State House and Senate, as well as state-wide office holders, by praying for them on a regular basis and sending them a postcard every month through the legislative session in March, April and May. Our goal is to cover in prayer all those “in authority” in North Carolina’s 180-member General Assembly, Council of State, the Lt. Governor and Governor.



The EAL program is never used to lobby and, therefore, is never confrontational. It is simply a great way to pray for our legislators and encourage them in their responsibilities. Many good relationships have started through the EAL program.
