National Day of Fasting, Repentance & Prayer

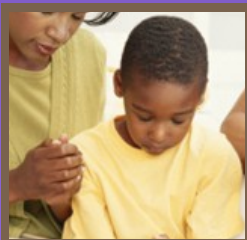

The Thursday before we feast, let's fast and prepare our hearts. Before we get caught up in the season of busyness, let us be grateful and prepare for Advent.

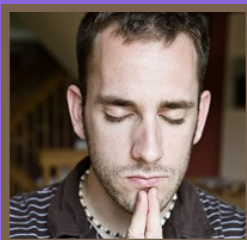
