



Open Letter to Sen. Johnny Isakson and Sen. Saxby Chambliss
Stop the Spending!

March 24, 2011

My name is Tanya Ditty, and I am the state director for Concerned Women for America (CWA) of Georgia. On behalf of the 12,000 CWA members who live in Georgia, I would like to express our concerns about the unprecedented 14 trillion dollar national debt and the need for our legislators to stand firm in demanding that deep cuts be made to out-of-control Washington spending.

As I write to you, the House, Senate, and President Obama are negotiating which programs will receive federal funding. We are requesting the following:

1. **Oppose any federal funding of Planned Parenthood.** As the nation's largest abortion provider, Planned Parenthood receives over \$360 million taxpayer dollars. And even more disturbing are the recent revelations that some Planned Parenthood employees are willingly protecting pimps who are exploiting and trafficking minors.

The Georgia General Assembly, with the support of Attorney General Sam Olens is on the eve of passing a human trafficking law that will help law enforcement and prosecutors go after human traffickers. How can one reconcile the fact that we have courageous state legislators who work to abolish, through legislation, human trafficking in our state, yet have a federal government who knowingly throws federal dollars at an organization who willingly protects the traffickers? It is unthinkable.

2. **Support the pro-life and pro-family provisions contained in H.R. 1.** We respectfully request that you speak with Senator Mitch McConnell and tell him to keep these provisions intact in the spending bills.
