Dear Senator,

On behalf of the 500,000 members of Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee (CWALAC) nationwide, I would like to urge you to support Senator Lindsey Graham's (R-South Carolina) resolution supporting sanctions for Iran, S. Res. 65, which would reaffirm the United States' support for Israel.

Since the people of Israel established a sovereign and independent state, the United States has shared a special bond of friendship with them. It has been more than sixty years, and the bipartisan support for Israel within the United States is still evident in Congress and among American citizens.

Our country must recognize the threat a nuclear Iran would pose, especially to that of our friend and ally, Israel. This resolution, which is not a declaration of war, would reestablish that support which the United States has historically shown, stating that "if Israel is compelled to take military action in self-defense against Iran's nuclear weapons program the U.S. government should provide Israel with diplomatic, military and economic support."

CWALAC supports Sen. Graham's resolution and reserves the right to include all floor votes in our annual scorecard.
