- SB 5 - Amendment 10 - CWA opposed - This amendment would have required maximum federal funding of women's health program for implementation.

- SB 5 - Amendment 16 - CWA opposed - This amendment would have required Texas to expand Medicare coverage to levels provided by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (aka Obamacare) or a successor law
