On the back, write one of the following messages:

This envelope represents one child who died in abortion.
It is empty because that life was unable to offer anything to the world.
Responsibility begins with conception.

OR

Sir, you said at the National Prayer Breakfast on February 5,
"There is no God Who condones taking the life of an innocent human being.
This much we know."
Please respect life in all your policies.

Place the envelope in the mail with proper postage and send it. Pray.
