Dear Senator Frist:

Concerned Women for America (CWA) congratulates you on the increase in your majority in the Senate and we look forward to working with you in the 109<sup>th</sup> Congress for the advancement of an agenda to improve the quality of American life.

We are concerned, however, that those hopes may be stillborn if Sen. Specter's reported comments about protecting the infamous *Roe v. Wade* decision are any indication of how he would conduct the Judiciary Committee if he were made chairman.

Sen. Specter has dismissed as "unlikely" the notion that he would allow a nominee who does not support the manifestly unconstitutional *Roe v. Wade* decision to be confirmed to the Supreme Court. Sen. Specter has signaled in advance that he does not intend to conduct the Judiciary Committee in a fair and impartial manner. Therefore, he has disqualified himself from consideration for that position.

We are aware that, as Majority Leader, you do not have unilateral power to determine committee chairmanships. However, we call on you to use your considerable influence to prevent Sen. Specter from being placed in a position of trust to which he is clearly not suited.
