

# 'Halted' Legislation for 2005

Defeated 2005

"Pro-homosexual" Legislation

HB 2116 would have added "sexual orientation" as prohibited discrimination and authorized action against such discrimination by a human rights commission in a county with the urban county executive form of government (Fairfax County).

DEFEATED: 17- 4.

HB 1633 would have repealed the statute that states: A civil union, partnership contract or other arrangement between persons of the same sex purporting to bestow the privileges or obligations of marriage is prohibited.

DEFEATED 17- 3.

SB 1077 Crimes against nature. Would have decriminalized sodomy.

DEFEATED 7 – 5.

## New Legislative Efforts

HB2868 would have allowed schools to prohibit homosexual clubs in the schools. It passed the House of Delegates but defeated in Senate Health and Education Committee (9-Y 6-N)

HB 2921 would have prevented those involved in homosexuality from adopting children in Virginia. It passed the House of Delegates but was defeated in Senate Courts of Justice without a roll call vote.
