## President Reagan's Memorial Day Prayer Proclamation, 1981

In recognition of those Americans whom we honor today, the Congress, by joint resolution of May 11, 1950 (64 Stat. 158), has requested the President to issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the United States to observe each Memorial Day as a day of prayer for permanent peace and a period during such day when the people of the United States might unite in prayer. Now, Therefore, I, Ronald Reagan, President of the United States of America, do hereby designate Memorial Day, Monday, May 25, 1981, as a day of prayer for permanent peace, and I designate the hour beginning in each locality at 11 o'clock in the morning of that day as a time to unite in prayer."

socialist-led federal government. In a recent interview Congresswoman Michelle Bachmann suggests that for a truly family-oriented agenda to advance, "voters will have to send to Washington more people with a Biblical world view."

Yet, where is the sounding alarm among Christian voters at the polls to elect candidates who support Biblical values? ## Common Core: End It, Don't Mend It

Common Core is the federal overhaul of our education system to create national K-12 standards. It was created by progressive private educational insiders in Washington, D.C., is a "one size fits all" plan that was never voted on, lacks involvement by teachers, parents, state and local legislators and is estimated to cost \$16 billion. The North Carolina State Legislative Hearings on Common Core (CC), held on February 20, this year, brought about citizen frustration when a carefully choreographed group of state educators were given time for comment, and the general public present at the Hearings were not given time for comments. However, even the educators expressed frustration with Common Core:

- \* Slow this down ... time out ... pause ... re-group! Many teachers are struggling.
- \* There is no correlation between test score results and what is learned.
- \* Not enough preparation time; way too much

testing, and testing is not learning.

- \* Teachers are unable to innovate curriculum for individual differences among children.
- \* CC testing equals teacher fear of job loss; test fatigue kills creativity.
- \* Children are guinea pigs for experimentation.
- \* CC drastically affects the poor and disabled students, negatively.
- \* CC is unproven to get the desired results.
- \* Student dropout rates will rise under CC.
- \* Pressure on teachers can plant the seed of apathy very quickly.
- \* CC appears to eliminate parents' rights and involvement.
- \* Many concerns over where education is heading.

Chaos in the classroom! A grassroots rage is growing among both political parties, as parents and teachers are clamoring to slow down or to stop Common Core. The general opinion among educators, teachers and parents is that Common Core is a NATIONAL DISASTER! It has not delivered as promised with more "rigorous,

internationally benchmarked standards," according to education expert, Dr. Sandra Stotsky. And education is reserved for state authority. According to Lt. Governor Forrest, "The real problem is no one is accountable for Common Core" as it moves into every school in the nation. He fervently believes that North Carolina can develop "our own best standards." Governor McCrory disagrees.

Huge "bribes and incentives," (I call the large donations given to governors from President Obama's Race to the Top stimulus package a bribe, because the states accepted these incentives without seeing what the so-called standards were) in support for Common Core are going to politicians from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, major leftist foundations, Agenda 21, and George Soros. Hence, both Republican and Democrat state governors and legislators are continuing to support Common Core with the backing from large endowments.

## National Legislative Update

### H.R. 3865: Stop Targeting of Political Beliefs by the IRS Act

The vote was 243 – 176 with 14 Democrats joining all Republicans in the House on February 26 2014, to pass H.R. 3865: Stop Targeting of Political Beliefs by the IRS. H.R. 3865 prohibits for one year, the Department of Treasury and the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) from finalizing their proposed 501(c)(4) regulations issued on November 29, 2013, keeping in place the regulations that were in effect on January 1, 2010. For over fifty years, under current regulation, an organization is eligible for a tax exemption under section 501(c)(4) of the

Internal Revenue Code if its primary focus is to promote social welfare. These organizations are allowed some degree of political campaign intervention as long as the campaign activities remain secondary to their primary purpose of social welfare. Non-partisan get-out-the vote (GOTV) efforts, voter registration drives, and candidate forums near an election are not considered political campaign intervention under current law. However, under the proposed rules published in November 2013, GOTV, voter registration and candidate forums would be redefined as political campaign intervention for 501(c)(4) organizations; if they engage in these activities they could jeopardize their exempt status. The proposed regulations are clearly directed at the Administration's critics, the very same kind of groups that the IRS

targeted in the period 2010 -2012.

North Carolina U.S. Senator Richard Burr co-sponsored S. B. # 2011 Stop Targeting of Political Beliefs by the IRS Act of 2014.

The bill which has 40 co-sponsors was introduced on February 11, 2014 and was read two times. It was referred to the Committee on Finance for further study. Some sources think the Senate is not likely to consider the bill and the President has indicated that he will veto it. The IRS could then muzzle conservative organizations and their efforts to inform voters near the time of elections.

**PRAY** for the President and the Senate to support S.B. 2011. Pray for all governing authorities to walk with integrity. "He who walks uprightly and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his

heart ... he who does these things shall never be moved” Psalm 15:2, 5.

**ACT NOW:** Call Senator Burr’s office at (202) 224-3154, to thank him for co-sponsoring S.B. 2011 Stop Targeting of Political Beliefs by the IRS Act of 2014. [Contact](#) President Obama and ask him not to veto S.B.; encourage him to sign this bill into law.

**H.R. 7: No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion and Abortion Insurance Full Disclosure Act of 2014**

Call and thank Congressman Robert Pittenger of North Carolina's 9th district for co-sponsored H.R. 7: No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion and Abortion

Insurance Full Disclosure Act.

**S. B. 2024, the State Marriage Defense Act.**

Senators Ted Cruz (R-Texas) and Mike Lee (R-Utah) introduced this bill to affirm a state's ability to pass legislation and constitutional amendments protecting traditional marriage between a man and a woman.

PRAY: that the United States Congress will pass S.B. 2024, the State Marriage Defense Act. Pray that God's truth will be revealed to the hearts of those who oppose traditional marriage. Pray that Attorney General Cooper will uphold North Carolina's Constitutional Marriage Amendment voted into law by 61

percent of the people of North Carolina, defining marriage according to God's Word, as between a husband and a wife according to Genesis 2: 24, "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh."

ACT NOW: Please call Senator Burr (202) 224-3154 and Senator Hagan (202) 224-6342 to co-sponsor S. B. 2024, the State Marriage Defense Act. Contact Attorney General Cooper to remain true to the oath he took to "support, maintain and defend" our state constitution, which includes our constitutional marriage amendment. **40 Days for Life Spring 2014 Vigil**

The Spring 2014 [40 Days for Life](#) vigil began on Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2014, in 253 locations worldwide and will conclude on Palm Sunday, April 13, 2014. [Five of those locations](#) are in cities here in North Carolina. 40 Days for Life is a time of prayer and fasting at abortion clinics for an end to abortion. It is also a time when many communities get involved in pro-life activities to educate and advocate for an end to abortion. Since 40 Days for Life was
