Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee and TV's Jim Bob and Michelle Duggar to Hold Amendment 1 Press Conference

NASHVILLE, TN -Reality television stars Jim Bob and Michelle Duggar will join Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee (CWALAC) of Tennessee, and Family Research Council Action in a press conference encouraging support for Tennessee Amendment 1 today, September 29, at 2:00 p.m. CST in the Legislative Plaza.

During the press conference the results of a recent poll on Amendment 1 commissioned by Family Research Council Action, and conducted by the Remington Research group will be released.

Joshua Duggar, President of Family Research Council Action said, "There are some key issues in front of Tennessee voters in November. One of significant importance is Amendment 1. Recently we have seen poll numbers on Amendment 1 which we do not believe are consistent with where the people of Tennessee really are on this issue. These poll numbers are likely the result of push polling. We conducted an opinion poll to highlight where the citizens really are on Amendment 1, and to help get the word out about this important issue. Tennessee voters need to understand the importance of passing this life saving measure."

Brenda Causey, CWALAC of Tennessee's State Director, said: " Tennessee residents call on passage of Amendment 1 so we can have the fair chance to debate the abortion issue. With the sad reality that our state has become an 'abortion destination' it is far past time that the Tennessee legislature hears from residents on whether the youngest and most vulnerable children should be excluded from a Constitutional right to life."

In addition to releasing the results of the resent poll the press conference will also include several speakers who will highlight the importance of the passage of Amendment 1. Those speakers include:
