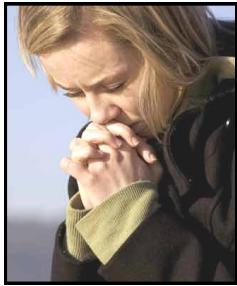

A Call to Prayer

I Timothy 2:1-2 instructs us to pray for our leaders. The Encourage-A-Legislator (EAL) Project offers our members and friends the vehicle to do just that in an easy and meaningful way.

By participating in CWA of California’s EAL Project, CWA members and friends are fulfilling the Biblical command in I Timothy 2:1-2 of praying for our leaders and living out the command to love one another, as well as being a good citizen. Please join us.



The Program

The goal of the EAL Project is to encourage each member of the Assembly and Senate by praying for them on a regular basis and sending them a postcard every month throughout one twelve-month period. Our aim is to cover all those “in authority” in the California legislature: 80 Assembly members and 40 Senate members.

The EAL Project is never used to lobby and, therefore, is never confrontational. It is simply a great way to lift up those in authority and encourage them in their responsibilities. Many good relationships have started through the EAL Project. We provide the name and address of the assigned legislator(s) and the post cards, and you commit to pray for your individual(s) every day the California legislature is in session and to mail an EAL postcard on the first day of every month. You may request a particular legislator. If that person is waiting for an encourager *and you live outside his/her district* you may be assigned that individual.
