Thank you for your tireless efforts to promote the well-being of my children (grades 7 and 12) and the other hundreds of students in our community educationally and socially. Your work is not is vain and please know that I and the Church that I lead pray for you and your staff each week. It was recently brought to my attention that there will be a "*Day of Silence" on April* 17.

This "event" was established and is being propagated by GLSEN (gay, lesbian, straight, education network) and not our students. This organization has been championing LGBT (lesbian, gay, bi-sexual, transgendered) issues in K-12 Education since 1990. They are encouraging school administrators to allow homosexual clubs (Gay Straight Alliance) to "remain silent" on April 17 this year in honor of students who are lesbian, gay, bi-sexual, or transgendered. While I very much believe in freedom of speech and value the "inalienable rights" set forth by our Nation's founders, I cannot agree that by definition of "inalienable rights," that being LGBT is either "natural" or moral. GLSEN, not students, has been pressing this unnatural and immoral view of human sexuality since 1990. This Divine Law is founded in love and has been set forth to promote purpose and peace in this life and the life to come (John 3:16).
