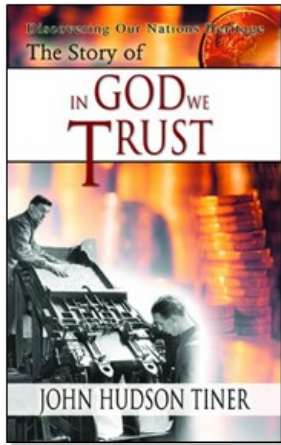
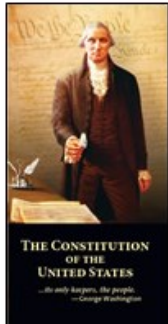


# Concerned Women for America of Missouri Constitution Day Project AD2015

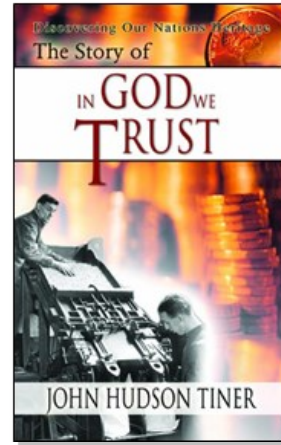
The gifts will be delivered to each member of the Missouri General Assembly at the State Capitol on Wednesday, September 16.

The gift will bear the sponsor's name and address so the elected official will know who sponsored their gift.

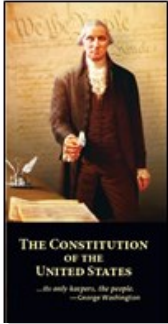
