A Call to Prayer

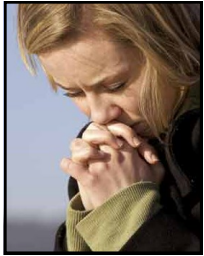

By participating in Concerned Women for America (CWA) of Missouri’s EAL program, CWA members and friends are fulfilling the Biblical command of praying for our leaders in I Timothy 2:1-2 and living out the command to love one another, as well as being a good citizen.

The Program

The goal of the EAL program is to encourage each member of the State House and Senate, as well as state-wide office holders, by praying for them on a regular basis and sending them a postcard every week throughout the legislative session, January to mid-May.

Our goal is to cover all those “in authority” in Missouri, 163 House members, 34 Senate members, and five state-wide office holders.



The EAL program is never used to lobby and, therefore, is never confrontational. It is simply a great way to lift up those in authority and encourage them in their responsibilities. Many good relationships have started through the EAL program.

We provide the name and address of the assigned office holder(s) and the post cards and you commit to praying for your individual(s) every Monday morning the Missouri General Assembly is in session and then mail the postcard that day.
