

Religious Freedom: Guard Against Ignorance

It is a national shame that any public display of religious freedom by Christians takes an act of moral courage. It is a national shame that students are forbidden, or dissuaded, from recognizing America's founding documents. It is a national shame that discussing the principles of our 239-year-old national heritage is considered "politically incorrect." How did we get to here? By way of public intimidation from New World Progressives and through uninformed Believers' ignorance of their religious rights.

Those who promote the invalid argument that the right of religious freedom, guaranteed by the First Amendment, is "separation of church and state", do not understand the U.S. Constitution: "Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of

religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof." The words, "separation of church and state" do not exist in the Constitution. And, those who tell us that "freedom from religion" is the same thing as "freedom of religion" are using fear and intimidation to keep Christians silent and ignorant of guaranteed religious rights. Let alone the obvious misuse of the English language.

Any public expression of Christian heritage, (i.e. the displaying of our national motto, *In God We Trust*, or praying in public) will no more establish a state religion than displaying the United Nation's motto, *It's Your World*, will establish world peace! The Federal Fifth, Ninth and Tenth Circuit Courts ruled our nation's motto, *In God We Trust*, "does not advance religion, it advances the national motto" (1996).

tyranny. In June, 2015, at the Day at the Capital in Raleigh, we met with legislators to urge support for SB 2, now law, which protects religious freedoms of the First amendment in the United States Constitution. Further, Article 1, Sec. 13 of the North Carolina Constitution, states that “no human authority shall ever interfere with the rights of conscience.” For more information on SB2 go to

The Iran Deal
It is interesting to me, that the **deadline for Congress to pass a resolution of disapproval on the Iran nuclear agreement was September 17**, which is also the day we celebrated Constitution Day. “We the People” thank our Lord for the blessings of freedom we enjoy today. We are

thankful for the thirty-nine dedicated Founding Fathers who signed this 228-year-old document at the Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia in 1787, risking their lives, fortunes, and honor.

Unfortunately, party politics won when Democrats blocked a final vote on advancing the Iran deal disapproval resolution with

a vote of 58-42. Constituents expect their senators to at least allow a vote on this deal. It is unacceptable that 98-1 Senators voted in May to have a vote on this agreement and now Democrats kept the Chamber from proceeding with that vote.

This vote is astounding despite the nearly 200

retired generals and admirals who wrote to Congress, urging lawmakers to reject the Iran nuclear agreement. And, as CWA’s Alexandria Paolozzi reported, according to a recent Gallup poll, 70% of Americans view Israel as a favorable ally.

Unfortunately our own president has supported this “Deal” all along. This deal is severely flawed. It is



dangerous to America, our ally Israel, and four Americans that were left behind and imprisoned.

Pain-Capable Unborn

Child Protection Act, SB 1670, is expected to be voted on by the Senate very soon. Go to govtrack.us/congress/bills/113/s1670 for status updates.

Pray: Pray for a change of heart of pro-abortion leaders.

Act: Contact North Carolina Senators Richard Burr (R) at burr.senate.gov/contact/email and Thom Tillis (R) at tillis.senate.gov/public/index.cfm/email-me to urge support for this pro-life legislation, SB 1670.

The Equality Act, H.R. 3185, is the most expansive “sexual orientation and gender identity” bill

introduced to date. In response, it is critical that the House passes The First Amendment Defense Act (FADA), H.R. 2802. FADA will prohibit the federal government from penalizing persons in federal employment, grants, contracts, tax treatment, and other programs for their moral or religious beliefs.

Pray: Pray that our religious freedom remain protected.

Slay the Giant Abortion: Your Voice Counts!

You are no doubt aware of the abhorrent business of selling infant body parts by Planned Parenthood. (View the videos and sign the petition at cwfa.org/help-us-defund-planned-parenthood-now. Read the summaries at cwfa.org/summary-of-the-center-for-medical-progress-videos.)

However barbaric the videos are, they are no hindrance to some who are completely unoffended, such as *The New England Journal of Medicine* who defends Planned Parenthood selling aborted babies (nejm.org/doi/full/10.1056/NEJMe1510281). Obama spokesman Josh Ernest admits not having seen the videos, yet he says Planned Parenthood follows “the highest ethical guidelines”

on medical research. (lifenews.com/2015/07/17/obama-spokesman-on-planned-parenthood-selling-aborted-baby-parts-they-say-theyre-ethical.)

Apparently, selling fetal body parts is legal and is protected under federal law. However, there are guidelines which are not being followed. Most reprehensible is the extremely unethical and vile practice of sacrificing pre-born babies to line the pockets of corrupt men and women with no regard for the health and safety of pregnant mothers and their unborn children.

Planned Parenthood clearly profits from “tissue donations” by collecting \$30 - \$100 from each aborted baby’s specimens at an estimated rate of over \$120,000 per month. Stem

Express, a bio-medical research company which procures fetal body parts, states that collaborating will, “contribute to the fiscal growth of your own clinic ... (and) will allow adding additional clinics quickly.”

The state of North Carolina requires lawful regulations involving abortion clinics. However, there is no requirement for an anesthesiologist or CRNA to administer anesthesia; nor is the abortion doctor required to be a board-certified OB/GYN. These and other less than proper standards should cause alarm for the women throughout North Carolina who entrust themselves to the care of these “medical clinics.”

Because human tissue procurement companies are using unborn baby parts at

19 weeks and abortion is legal up to 20 weeks in North Carolina, abortion clinics must be investigated. Gov. McCrory must be held accountable to investigate the state's 21 abortion clinics regarding the selling of aborted baby parts as exposed in the recent Planned Parenthood video scandal. Sadly, although many have contacted the Governor's office, a decision has not been made to open investigations into the state's abortion clinics.

Pray: Pray that Planned Parenthood will be defunded and that abortion will end in our state and nation. "Open your mouth for the speechless, in the cause of all who are appointed to die. Open your mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy". (Proverbs 31:8-9)

Act: Call Gov. McCrory at (919) 814-2000 / (919) 733-2120) or email him at

governor.office@nc.gov and urge an investigation of the state's 21 abortion clinics.
