## Encourage-A-Legislator 2017 Campaign



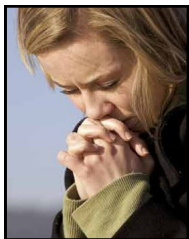

The goal of the Encourage-A-Legislator campaign is to encourage each member of our State House and Senate by designating one volunteer to pray for one legislator each day during the Legislative session.



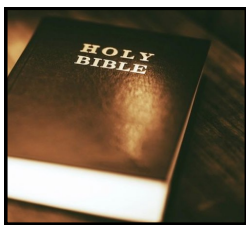
## The Program

Every week CWA of Texas provides a post card that the volunteer jots a quick encouraging message to the Legislator during the

twenty-week session from January to May. These cards are never used to address issues being considered, therefore, they are received by Legislators as non-partisan words of encouragement for their important task.

## The Point

By participating in CWA of Texas' Encourage-A-Legislator campaign you will be fulfilling the instruction in I Timothy 1:1-2, "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people for kings and all those in authority that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."
