1. Will you support the protection of the unborn from abortion, sale of fetal body parts, and destructive embryonic research?
2. Will you support the protection of society from euthanasia, cloning, population control and human-animal genetic engineering?
3. Will you support the right of Georgia citizens, businesses and organizations to act in accordance with their deeply held religious beliefs and ensure that the state in no way limits their ability to express their religious beliefs?
4. Will you actively support the Legislature in its efforts to pass an uncompromised, state-level RFRA that mirrors the federal RFRA, and then sign the bill if it passes?
5. Will you support the formation of a special protected class based on sexual orientation and/or gender identity?
6. Will you support the expansion of gambling in Georgia, such as but not limited to casinos, horse racing, pari-mutual betting and Daily Fantasy Sports?
7. Will you support in-state cultivation of marijuana in violation of federal drug laws and regulations?
8. Will you support the legalization of marijuana for recreational use?
9. Will you oppose Georgia's continued participation in the Common Core national standards initiative or future participation in any other national standards movement, such as Next Generation Science, social studies, and health and sex education?
10. Will you support the right of parents to be informed by local school systems about any sexually related content (including content about family structure and/or transgender ideology) in coursework, classroom discussion, or activities, and allow them to opt-out their children?
11. Will you support legislation that would prohibit the State Board of Education from adopting Social Emotional Learning standards and/or embedding such non-academic, psychological standards and assessments in other curricula?
12. Will you use the power of the Governor's office to protect students from invasion of their privacy, safety, and dignity in private areas, such as but not limited to, restrooms and locker rooms, and ensure schools do not usurp parental authority in any matters related to sex and gender?
13. Will you work to bolster state and individual rights against federal overreach, whether those rights involve health care, environmental issues, education, agriculture, or any other aspect of public policy that is within the jurisdiction of state government?
14. Will you use the power of the Governor's office to support a resolution that would allow voters to decide whether the state constitution will be amended to make English the official language of government in Georgia?
