

General Voter Information

REGISTRATION QUALIFICATIONS

- 18 years of age to vote, 17 1/2 years of age to register
- US Citizen
- Missouri Resident

If an individual meets these requirements, they are entitled to register to vote.

TO BE ENTITLED TO VOTE, A PERSON:

- 1. Must be registered to vote in the jurisdiction of the person's domicile prior to the election:
- 2. Cannot be imprisoned;
- 3. Cannot be on probation or parole after conviction of a felony;
- 4. Cannot have been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor connected to voting; and
- 5. Cannot have been declared incapacitated.

WHERE TO REGISTER TO VOTE

- Complete a Missouri Voter Registration Application Form and submit to your local county election authority office.
- The Voter Registration Form can be downloaded from the Missouri Secretary of State website. You cannot register online.
- Visit your local county election authority office and register in person.
- Register at any Department of Motor Vehicles office or state agency providing service to the public (WIC, Social Services, etc)

POLLING PLACES ARE OPEN FROM 6:00 AM TO 7:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY.

Important: If you are in line at the closing time of 7:00 PM you have the right to cast your vote
