Some of the subject matter that will be discussed:

- Adults over the age of 30 were identified as 'children' in order to qualify for benefits. No documents were required to verify age.
- United States Immigration and Customs Service uncovered massive fraud in the Deferred Action for Arrivals (known as DACA)
- States were assigned quotas to receive these immigrants, and social security numbers were given to each of them.
- Women and children seldom arrive in our country; contrary to what the government reports to the public.
