PRAYER GUIDE



Tuesday, August 28, 2018 – Pray for Justice in America

Prayer: Holy Father, we do not seek to be trivial but thorough. We depend on You for everything we have. We praise Your name for the very air we breathe. And we lay at Your feet the preservation of justice and righteousness in our land.

Supplication: Help us thirst for justice and remember its true meaning. Forgive us for perverting it and seeking our own prideful ways, instead of what is truly good and true.

Thanksgiving: We thank You for Your mercy and grace towards us.

Request: Help Judge (and future-Justice) Kavanaugh to not grow cynical in the application and preservation of justice, but to depend on You more and more when the tasks and pressures associated with the position You've bestowed on him become increasingly harder.

Wednesday, August 29, 2018 – Pray for the President and His Team

Thursday, August 30, 2018 – Pray for the U.S. Supreme Court
