- ➔ Let your elected officials know what you think about issues that are important to pro-life Mainers.
- ➔ Meet your State Representative and State Senator and let them know where you stand.

TO PARTICIPATE:

1. Contact Your Representatives and ask them to OPPOSE LD 820 and LD 1261. Find your [Senator](#) and your [Representative](#) both listed alphabetically by town. A brief telephone call can be more effective, so if time permits, please call. Otherwise, please be sure to at least email your legislator.
2. **What should I do in advance of the lobby day on Thursday, May 2?**
 - Make an appointment with your representative and senator for the morning of May 2.
 - Sign up for the lobby day [here](#).

Complete one registration for each attendee in your group with the same legislators. If you are coming with others, only one person per legislative district needs to fill out the form. (for example, if you and your friends all are represented by John Smith, only one of you needs to fill out the form).

3. **What can I do if I cannot come on May 2?**

Be sure to call your legislators and urge them to oppose the bills. Encourage others to come to the lobby day even if you cannot.

The State House is located on the corners of Capitol and State Streets in Augusta.

To get to the State House from I-95 get off at exit 109 and travel east on route 202 (Western Avenue). Continue to the first rotary where you take the first possible right turn onto State Street. Proceed to the traffic light where you will see the State House in front of you on the right. Turn right at the light onto Capitol Street for access to parking behind the Cross Office Building or in the Sewall Street garage. Parking may also be available south of the State House, behind the State Library, Archives and Museum building.
