Dear Mr. President,

On behalf of our hundreds of thousands of members, we thank you for your exemplary leadership at the 74th United Nations General Assembly. What a joy to see the United States lead the world by example in the defense of life and religious liberty.

We are grateful for your tireless defense of life since the beginning of your administration. Under your leadership, and that of Secretary Pompeo and Secretary Azar, twenty countries joined the United States in the Joint Statement on Universal Health Coverage to declare there is no international right to abortion and that terms related to abortion, such as “sexual and reproductive health and rights” (SRH), have no place in UN documents.
