Dear Sen. Collins,

I am writing on behalf of the members of Concerned Women for America (CWA) of Maine to respectfully ask that you do not vote for more witnesses in the impeach trial of President Donald Trump. The House had ample opportunity to call witnesses to support their accusations against the president. Indeed, they called all the witnesses they wanted (17 to be precise). Calling additional witnesses will only elongate the impeachment proceedings, which is not in the best interest of the country. It was clear from your well-crafted questions that the Democrats will not be satisfied with whatever any witness says. To try to appease them is to play right into their hand. As usual, you will not be given any credit when it is all set and done.
