I am writing on behalf of the hundreds of thousands of supporters of Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee (CWALAC) to condemn the malicious partisan impeachment process that the House of Representatives commenced.


The Constitution provides that the Senate “shall have the sole Power to try all Impeachments” and we call on you to stand against this malicious effort to remove a duly elected president and undo the will of the American electorate.

The two ambiguous articles sent to you simply do not meet the constitutional standard of impeachment for “treason, bribery, or other high crimes and misdemeanors.” These are serious charges that require conclusive evidence, not merely hearsay testimony of the most unreliable nature.

CWALAC is outraged by the assault on due process and the trivialization of constitutional standards, which led the House of Representatives to charge the President with “abuse of power and obstruction of Congress.” By such ambiguous terms, any president in history could have been impeached. And the longer the Senate continues to entertain such bogus charges, the more likely it seems this will become a trend going forward.

All Senators should stand against impeaching the President of the United States under such dubious charges. Impeachment of a U.S. President should never proceed for the purpose of overturning an election that did not satisfy the opposing political party. CWALAC will score against any vote in support of this shameful article of impeachment from the Senate, and we will include this vote on our annual scorecard.
