SIX-WEEK PRAYER GUIDE



"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." Philippians 4:6

- Pray for the people's anxiety and concerns over the election.
- As we enter this Christmas season, let us pray for peace in Georgia and goodwill towards our neighbors (Luke 2:14).
- Let us pray for awareness of the issues at stake in this election. Pray against fatigue and apathy. Pray for a renewed sense of hope.
- Let us also pray for more Christian volunteers to come forth with a burden to mobilize and safeguard the elections.

"Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." James 5:16

- Say a prayer of confession and repentance for our sins as a nation. Let us confess our pride and our idolatry. Let us repent of the sin of abortion and for our silence in the face of evil.
- Pray for the people of Georgia. Ask that God may reveal what is at stake, and for a sense of urgency to be involved in the election. Let us declare our trust
- in the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. That we may work hard, and then rest saying, "Thy will be done" (Mt. 6:10).

"For the Lord loves justice; he will not forsake his saints. They are preserved forever, but the children of the wicked shall be cut off." Psalm 37:28

- Let us pray for justice in the election. Let us pray for justice in our government and in our courts.
- Pray against the enemy's schemes. Pray that those who are planning traps against fair elections will be exposed.
- Let us pray also against big interests, like Big Tech, silencing voices. May truth reach its intended destination. Pray that God multiply our efforts hundredfold, so that many will join in the pursuit of true justice.

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

- Let us pray with joy and thanksgiving. Let us lift our voices and declare that God is good.
- Give thanks to the LORD for His providential ruling over all aspects of the election.
- Pray that people are reminded that we can make a difference.
- Pray for the preparations being made for election day. Pray for the workers and for the technology that will be used.
- Let us pray for the messaging and the media. That truth may break through the enemy's attempt to mislead and discourage.

"When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; but when a wicked man rules, the people groan." Proverbs 29:2

- We pray for the righteous to rule in Georgia and in our country.
- Pray for the U.S. Senate dynamics that are developing even now as Georgia gets ready to elect its senators.
- Let us lift our voices against the wicked whose self-serving plans bring only grief to the people.
- Let us pray for healing and unity in our country. For revival.
- Pray for U.S. policy and the many issues senators will have to consider: COVID-19, economic policy, the protection of life, the support of the family, the safeguards for women and children, among others.
