On behalf of the hundreds of thousands of women we represent across the country, Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee (CWALAC) writes to enthusiastically endorse the “Protecting Life on College Campus Act of 2021.”


The Protecting Life on College Campus Act of 2021 will prohibit federal funds from going to universities that provide chemical abortion pills to students. This legislation will save lives and protect taxpayer money from funding abortions.

[Domestic and international studies](#) have revealed that the abortion pill is more dangerous than surgical abortion, including risks such as more bleeding and pain and potential need for surgical completion due to excessive bleeding, retained pregnancy tissue, or failure to kill the fetus. In fact, one study found that [7% of women](#) who took the abortion pill required surgery. Furthermore, there have been [24 reported maternal deaths](#) and more than [4,000 adverse events](#) from women who took the pill.

Having the chemical abortion pill readily available on college campuses is detrimental to the safety, health, and well-being of students. As Concerned Women for America has Young Women for America chapters on college campuses across the country, this issue is critically important to us and our college leaders. Out of care and compassion for the young women on college campuses, we applaud you for introducing the Protecting Life on College Campus Act of 2021.

We thank you and all of the bill’s cosponsors for fighting to protect life in the womb as well as to protect young women on college campuses through this important legislation.
