
The Democrats' \$3.5 trillion budget plan, S. Con. Res. 14, is a nuclear attack on bipartisanship and saturated with extreme policy objectives. This bloated blueprint will upend our economy, recklessly expand our debt, and trigger a troubling expansion of taxes and tone-deaf government mandates for American families.

The vote-a-rama underway serves as a clear record of Senators' willingness to stand strong on core American values. Hundreds of amendments have been filed for consideration. We ask Senate leadership to allow multiple votes to inform the American people of members' positions on the following critical issues. CWALAC reserves the right to include on our scorecard any amendment votes in these categories:

- Votes in favor of upholding the sanctity of human life, including protections for abortion survivors and unborn children with Down syndrome.
- Votes in favor of prohibiting taxpayer funding for abortion or discrimination against those who refuse to participate in abortion, such as the Lankford/Daines/Blunt amendment.
- Votes in favor of prohibiting abortion providers from receiving Paycheck Protection Program loan forgiveness, such as the Paul amendment.
- Votes in favor of prohibiting dangerous gender transition procedures for vulnerable children and protecting the conscience rights of medical providers.
- Votes in favor of protecting the rights of female athletes for biologically based women's sports.
- Votes in favor of preventing biological male inmates identifying as women from being placed in or transferred to female prison facilities.
- Votes in favor of protecting young women from being forced to register for the draft, such as the Lee amendment.
- Votes in favor of prohibiting funding for unethical research including human animal chimeras.
- Votes in favor of prohibiting inclusion of critical race theory in education or workforce training.
- Votes in favor of upholding election law integrity or preventing federal taxpayers from funding political campaigns.
- Votes against attempts to undermine these objectives or reverse their adoption.

We urge the Senate to work constructively to craft a fiscally responsible budget that respects American values and rejects forcing American workers to finance an expansion of the federal government's reach into our lives, liberties, and pocketbooks.
