| 1/4/21 | H. Res. 8 Adopting the rules of the House for the 117th Congress | Prohibits the use of sex-specific pronouns or family relationships | Opposed | Passed |
| 2/25/21 | H.R. 5 Equality Act | Redefines sex in civil rights laws to include sexual orientation and gender identity, effectively erasing women's status | Opposed | Passed |
| 2/27/21 | H.R. 1319 American Rescue Plan Act | Removes protections against taxpayer funding of abortion on demand | Opposed | Passed |
| 3/3/21 | H.R. 1 For the People Act | Institutes a federal takeover of state voting laws, forces taxpayers to fund political campaigns, and requires nonprofits to disclose donors | Opposed | Passed |
| 3/17/21 | H. J. Res. 17 Removing the deadline for ratification of the Equal Rights Amendment | Erases the unique status and dignity of females by eliminating legal safeguards that recognize differences between men and women | Opposed | Passed |
| 4/15/21 | H.R. 7 Paycheck Fairness Act | Redefines sex in fair labor laws to include sexual orientation and gender identity | Opposed | Passed |
| 4/19/21 | H.R. 1996 SAFE Banking Act | Legitimizes the marijuana industry financially and grants marijuana businesses access to the federal banking system | Opposed | Passed |
| 6/15/21 | H.R. 1443 LGBTQ Business Equal Credit Enforcement and Investment Act | Collects the sexual behavior and gender preferences of business owners | Opposed | Failed |

| 6/23/21 | H. Res. 486 (procedural vote) | Blocks immediate floor consideration of H.R. 18, the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion and Abortion Insurance Full Disclosure Act | Opposed | Passed |
| 6/24/21 | H.R. 1443 LGBTQ Business Equal Credit Enforcement and Investment Act | Collects the sexual behavior and gender preferences of business owners | Opposed | Passed |
| 7/28/21 | H.R. 4373 FY 2022 Appropriations | Eliminates a ban on funding abortion overseas, removes a ban on abortion for federal prisoners, and exempts recreational marijuana from federal oversight | Opposed | Passed |
| 7/29/21 | H.R. 4502 FY 2022 Appropriations (procedural vote) | Request to restore bipartisan pro-life protections against taxpayer funding of elective abortion | Supported | Failed |
| 7/29/21 | H.R. 4502 FY 2022 Appropriations | Repeals all longstanding pro-life protections in the federal budget, including the Hyde Amendment | Opposed | Passed |
| 8/24/21 | H.R. 4 John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act | Subjects state election laws to federal approval under the discretion of Department of Justice political appointees | Opposed | Passed |
| 9/23/21 | H.R. 4350 National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2022 | Requires young women to register with the Selective Service for a potential military draft (**See end note) | Opposed | Passed |
| 9/24/21 | H.R. 3755 Women’s Health Protection Act (procedural vote) | Request to require care for babies born alive after an attempted abortion | Supported | Failed |
| 9/24/21 | H.R. 3755 Women’s Health Protection Act | Invalidates nearly every state restriction on abortion nationwide | Opposed | Passed |
| 10/26/21 | H.R. 2119 Family Violence Prevention and Services Improvement Act | Imposes radical gender ideology on faith-based providers and jeopardizes care for female abuse victims | Opposed | Passed |
| 11/5/21 | Senate Amendment to H.R. 3684 INVEST in America Act | Uses infrastructure projects to promote an ideological agenda, including new federal dictates around “actual and perceived” gender identities | Opposed | Passed |
| 11/19/21 | H.R. 5376 Build Back Better Act | Multi-trillion-dollar social welfare spending spree mandating cradle-to-grave government interventions and federally funded abortion on demand | Opposed | Passed |

| Ongoing | Sign the H. Res. 274 Discharge Petition | Provides for immediate floor consideration of H.R. 619 Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act | Supported | 213 signatures (Need 218) |
| Ongoing | Cosponsor H.R. 1440 Fairness for All Act | Mandates that gender perceptions override biological fact in federal civil rights law | Opposed | 21 cosponsors |

** (Note: Certain House members who objected to the “draft our daughters” provision voted YES on H.R. 4350 to advance the larger National Defense Authorization Act process. The Senate did not hold a separate vote on a companion version. House and Senate negotiators eventually removed the “draft our daughters” provision from a compromise bill that passed both chambers. CWALAC withdrew our objections and did not score the final vote in either chamber.)
