117th Congress Scorecard

Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee identified a series of key votes for the 117th Congress reflecting positions on CWA’s core issues and the values of the hundreds of thousands of citizens we represent across the country.

This scorecard serves as a measure of a Member’s stance on critical national issues, including the sanctity of life, religious freedom, election integrity, protections for women, education, illegal drug regulation, and support for Israel.

The final cumulative scores provide a metric for voters to evaluate their elected officials. In order to capture the full significance of the enactment of the so-called Respect for Marriage Act, which is an existential attack on the institution of marriage, we double-weighted its score and have highlighted in **RED** the legislators who voted for it to become law.
