Res. 4 – A joint resolution removing the deadline for the ratification of the Equal Rights Amendment	The Senate was trying to unconstitutionally remove a previous set deadline from the ratification of the Equal Rights Amendment. Additionally, CWALAC disagrees with the Equal Rights Amendment as it would enshrine abortion into law.	Opposed	Passed
4/19/23	S.J. Res. 10 – A joint resolution providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the rule submitted by the Department of Veterans Affairs relating to “Reproductive Health Services”	The Biden administration unlawfully implemented a rule allowing abortion procedures to take place through the Department of Defense. Senator Tuberville (R-AL) brought a vote to the Senate Floor to overturn the Biden Administration’s abortion rule.	Supported	Failed

Res. 42 – A joint resolution providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the	In 2022 the Department of Agriculture announced that it was expanding the definition of discrimination based on “sex” found in Title IX to include gender identity. Under its new policy, any school receiving funds for lunch programs would be forced to implement this rule	Supported	Failed

Clayton County to Program Discrimination Complaint Processing-Policy Update”	by accepting boys in girl’s sports, boys in girl’s bathroom, etc.. Senator Roger Marshall (R-KS) brought a vote to the Senate floor to overturn the rule.		
12/13/23	H.R. 2670 – National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2024	Due to the Senate stripping all the House’s substantive amendments that CWALAC tracked and scored (as seen on our House scorecard), CWALAC scored the final Senate vote.	Opposed	Passed
