1/11/23	H.R. 26 – Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act	H.R. 26 protects babies who are born alive in abortion attempts by affirming the baby’s legal personhood and recognizing the baby’s right to medical care.	Supported	Passed
4/20/23	H.R. 734 – Protection of Women and Girls in Sports Act of 2023	H.R. 734 ensures that only women can compete in women’s sports. It rightly clarifies the responsibility of schools receiving federal funds to prohibit discrimination against female athletes based on biological sex. It recognizes that women and girls are denied their rights to equality in sports when Title IX is not used to defend them.	Supported	Passed

7/13/23	H.Amdt.223 to H.R. 2670	An amendment to the NDAA to prohibit TRICARE from covering and the Department of Defense from furnishing sex reassignment surgeries and gender hormone treatments for transgender individuals	Supported	Passed
7/13/23	H.Amdt.224 to H.R. 2670	An amendment to the NDAA to prohibit provision of gender transition procedures, including surgery or medication, through the Exceptional Family Member Program	Supported	Passed
1/18/24	H.R.6914 - Pregnant Students' Rights Act	This bill requires each institution of higher education (IHE) that participates in federal student aid programs to provide certain information to prospective and enrolled students on the rights and resources for pregnant students to carry a baby to term or students who may become pregnant while enrolled at the IHE to carry a baby to term. 1/18/24	H.R.6918 - Supporting Pregnant and Parenting Women and Families Act	To prohibit the Secretary of Health and Human Services from restricting funding for pregnancy centers.	Supported	Passed
1/31/24	H.R.6679 - No Immigration Benefits for Hamas Terrorists Act	To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act with respect to aliens who carried out, participated in, planned, financed, supported, or otherwise facilitated the attacks against Israel.	Supported	Passed
4/18/24	H.Res.1143 - Condemning Iran's unprecedented drone and missile attack on Israel.	(1) condemns Iran's drone and missile attack on Israel; (2) stands with Israel as it defends itself against Iran's attacks and reaffirms the U.S. commitment to Israel's security; (3) supports Israel's right to self-defense and right to respond to this aggression; (4) commends the U.S. military, the United Kingdom, France, and Jordan for intercepting Iranian missiles and drones; and (5)	Supported	Passed
