Presidential Debate Prayer Points

01

Worship God Who Rules Over the Affairs of Men

“Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.” – Psalm 127:1

Pray affirming God sovereignty over all things and our reliance on Him alone as the source of our hope and strength. Pray in faith knowing He hears our prayers and will not turn away a sincere and contrite heart. Pray in thanksgiving and confidence that His will be done in all things, including in the upcoming election, and more specifically this week’s debate.

Pray for Mercy and Grace Over our People, Our Leaders, and Our Land

“[I]f my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.” – 2 Chronicles 7:14

Pray for the merciful heart of God to abound in our land. Ask for forgiveness for our sins of commission and omission. Pray for those who have rebelled against the Almighty, sometimes not even knowing what they do. Pray for God’s grace to shine upon us. Let us pray that the scales that cover our people’s spiritual eyes would fall off that they may see our dire situation. Pray that they may better understand our desperate spiritual condition even as they hear this presidential debate, covering some of the most pressing issues of our day.

Pray Against the Enemy's Schemes

“Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.” – Ephesians 6:11-12

Pray for the enemies of God to be confounded and their plans frustrated at every turn. Pray that evil may be exposed and that the light of Truth may be palpable to all who are watching the debate. Pray that the light may shine so brightly that the darkness has no part of it or has no place to be.

Pray for the Candidates

“First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.”

– 1 Timothy 2:1-2

Pray for both candidates. Pray that God may intervene in their preparations and that truth will find its way out of their mouths and hearts at every turn. Pray that all deceptive tactics will come to nothing. Pray that shame may come over where they have espoused policies that are contrary to all goodness and godliness. Pray against all anti-family, anti-life, anti-religious freedom, anti-liberty ideas. Pray that the Word of God will play a great part in their preparation so that truth and justice may be the main themes that affirm or convict their thinking.

Finally, Pray for Wisdom for Our People

“If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.” – James 1:5

Pray for godly wisdom for our citizens. Pray that everyone watching the debate may see beyond the propaganda and media deceptions. Pray that truth would be evident. Pray for a look beyond traditional political lines and into the fundamental principles that undergird our freedoms. Pray for a longing for God's blessing upon us—a longing for righteousness in our culture. Pray for loving hearts which seek the best for our children and our children's children. Let us ask for the wisdom that affirms God's ways are best.
