Dear Senators,

I write on behalf of the hundreds of thousands of members of Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee (CWALAC) to express our support of President Trump's nominee for director of the Office of Management and Budget, Russell Vought.

Nearly every American agrees that the size and scope of the federal government is out of control. It wastes money on useless and ineffective programs, and its employees are too numerous. Agencies regularly implement rules that hurt American families, from onerous environmental policies to unnecessary business restrictions. Americans want less government in their lives; the path to greater efficiency runs through OMB.

Perhaps Vought's greatest qualification for the job is his stellar performance in reigning in out of control agencies during the first Trump administration. Vought worked tirelessly to reform the federal bureaucracy, making it more difficult for agencies to issue guidance without going through the formal rulemaking process. He instructed agencies to stop teaching divisive critical race theory. He authored Schedule F, a plan that, if implemented, would have resulted in a drastically smaller and more accountable federal workforce. He frequently released budget plans that cut trillions in discretionary spending without touching Social Security and Medicaid.

CWALAC members, like most Americans, want the government to work in the best interest of the people. OMB is the linchpin to cleaning out inefficient government agencies, and making them work, once again, for the people. We know that Russ Vought was committed to putting Americans first as Director of OMB four years ago, and we are confident that he will do so again. We urge you to vote for his swift confirmation.
