Among our many efforts are the introduction of CWA of Pennsylvania's Faith Month Resolution, the Early Human Life Development Education bill, commonly referred to as "Baby Olivia," as well as critical issues focused on protecting women's sports, age verification for online content, and opposing abortion expansion within the state.
- Attended and tabled at an inspiring summit in Sewickley, Pennsylvania, in June to promote practical solutions for internet safety and to intensify efforts against child exploitation and trafficking.

It was a momentous event as thousands of dedicated individuals gathered for the largest March for Life in the state's history.



- **Prayed and encouraged our elected state officials regularly for our fifth year through our Encourage-A-Legislator program, in which volunteers regularly prayed for and sent encouraging postcards.**
- **Held our first Christmas at the Capitol, which took place on December 8. The day began with a spiritual tour of the Capitol, followed by a legislative update from conservative statewide legislators and CWA national speakers, and concluded with a time of prayer.**
